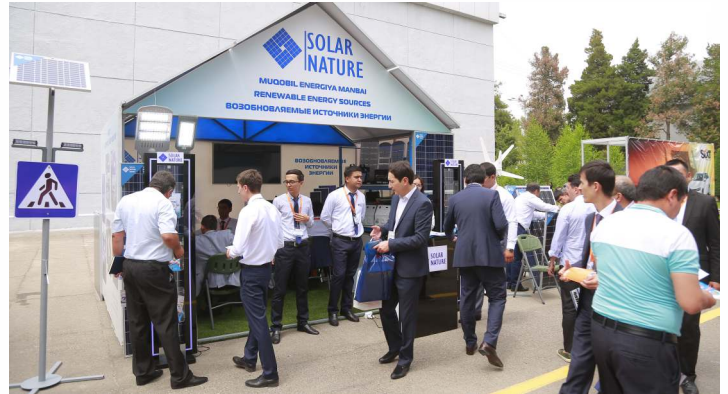

# WHY UZBEKISTAN?

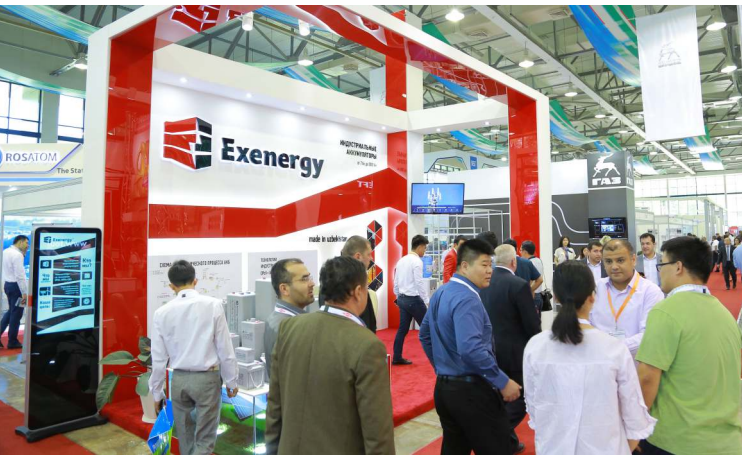
- ☞ has great potential for alternative energy sources
- ☞ the population of Uzbekistan has exceeded 35 million and, according to UN forecasts, by 2030 the population of the country will increase to 37 million people
- ☞ the need to solve an important social task of providing electricity consumers of rural regions of the republic with a population of 15 million people located in areas of decentralized power supply
- ☞ the economy's need for energy resources will increase and the possibilities of using limited hydrocarbon resources
- ☞ favorable investment climate
- ☞ introduction of public-private partnership (PPP) mechanisms

**The main components of Renewables (RES) in Uzbekistan are solar, wind, hydropower, biomass energy.**



**Significant government support is provided for participants in the implementation of RES, such as:**

- exemption from customs duties (except for customs duties) of equipment, raw products and materials, components, devices, spare parts, technological documentation, not produced in the republic;
- exemption from all types of taxes for a period of five years from the date of the state registration of manufacturers of RES equipment;
- tariffs for electricity generated from renewable energy sources, determined on the basis of competitive bidding;
- a number of other preferences and benefits not only for individuals and companies creating renewable energy facilities and supplying energy from renewable energy sources, but also for consumers of this energy and etc.
